Position Summary:

The Human Resources / Administrative Assistant is responsible for assisting the Human Resources department with the day to day HR functions and responsibilities, as well as, assist Scheduling and Payroll with the preparation, processing and reconciliation of scheduling and payroll on a regular basis.

The Human Resources / Administrative Assistant assists with the day to day Human Resources and Payroll functions and duties. They will also assist the Scheduling staff with publishing the rosters, following up with employees and their supervisors and managing leave requests. The individual will carry out responsibilities in the following functional areas: Human Resources Information systems, employee relations, employee orientation, benefit administration, recruitment and tracking, scheduling, leave administration, preparing payroll, reconciliation, distribution and transmission of payroll on a biweekly basis. The incumbent may be required to perform any other additional duties, related to Human Resources or Payroll

- Degree or Diploma in Business, Accounting / Finance, Human Resources or Labor Relations or any related discipline, or equivalent.
- Two years' experience in Administration, Human Resources Generalist / Assistant role or related field.
