Community Living - South Muskoka requires a **Family Support Worker** to provide support and service co-ordination to families, children and school age youth with developmental disabilities residing in South and West Muskoka.

Duties will include:

- Assist families in identifying appropriate services for their child and make referrals to supportive services
- Support families with school advocacy and school meetings
- Assist families and school personnel with transition planning for the student
- Provide families with family education in regards to their child's disability
- Support with financial coordination with completing applications for financial assistance
- · Assess the needs of the family in terms of respite needs and services
- Complete Individual Family Support Plans

Qualifications:

- The successful applicant should have a degree or diploma in the Human Services Field or an acceptable equivalent.
- A minimum of three (3) years experience working with families and supporting school age children and youth with developmental delays and disabilities is required.
- Must have the ability to work independently and with minimal supervision.
- Highly developed communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must possess: good organizational and time management skills.
- Knowledge of, and ability to network with community resources.
- Commitment to a team approach and to the principle of community integration.
- A valid driver's license and reliable vehicle with appropriate liability insurance is required
- Good attendance and performance record
